The two parties have worked together since 1993, when Carajas became Modular's first fleet-management system customer in Brazil.

"We've continued to expand our partnership with Vale to encompass a total of 14 sites. Earlier this year, we celebrated the signing of Vale's Pico mine as our 250th customer," said Davi Freire, general manager, Modular Brazil.

Carajás first installed the MasterLink 2 network in 2004 and later upgraded to MasterLink 11 in 2007, according to Modular. The mine's usage of bandwidth-intensive applications, its need to support multiple virtual local area networks, and increased coverage requirements, drove the mine to upgrade its wireless platform.
